How does it work?

- 1. Sign up:** Get in touch, fill out an info form, start thinking of ways to connect your campus.
- 2. Meetings will be conducted online – this will allow all members, whether in **Saskatoon** or **Halifax** to participate in meetings.
- 3. Coordinate and participate in events on campus:** Each connector participates in two or more campus events per semester. Events could include representation at campus volunteer fairs, documentary film screenings, presentations to students, frosh week, concerts, rallies and other events on global issues.
- 4. Network and communicate with YCI:** As you attend events and network on campus you will stay in touch with YCI and together we'll increase the presence of youth development initiatives on campuses across Canada.
